

Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District (MROSD) Slender False Brome (SFB) Reimbursement Plan

Reimbursement = \$350 per acre treated.

Slender False Brome Management Program Steps

1. Homeowner/MROSD schedule Pre-treatment Survey.
2. MROSD conducts Pre-treatment Survey.
Homeowner receives SFB Control Recommendation, a map of SFB infestation on their property, and reimbursement calculation.
3. Homeowner agrees with Control Recommendation and reimbursement.
Homeowner signs and returns Program Agreement.
4. Homeowner applies control practice or hires a professional.
SFB Coordinator will be available for on-site consultation at the start of treatment if necessary.
5. MROSD conducts Post-treatment Survey and completes Reimbursement Form.
6. MROSD issues check.

Funds have been allocated to treat each property twice. Once the initial treatment has been conducted, MROSD will follow-up with Homeowners to schedule the follow-up treatment following steps 1-6 above.
