 Enter into long term lease, prepare site plan (79)

Single-Track Trail
 Narrow road-width trail to single-track (71)

Alma College Complex
 Rehabilitate chapel, retain shrines, demolish all other structures (78)

Single-Track Trail
 Narrow road-width trail to single-track (71)

Existing Roads and Trails
 Remove permit system, repair problem areas (65, 71, 88)

New Parking Area
 20-30 vehicle spaces, 3-5 horse trailer spaces, permanent restroom; retain horse trailer space at BC02 (68, 69)

 Designate off-leash dog area within former vineyard site (80)

 Trail easement through Presentation Center lands (73)

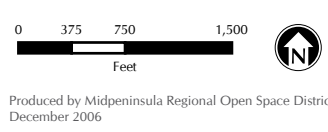
