

Renewal of GIS Software Enterprise Agreement

GENERAL MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION



Authorize the General Manager to renew a three-year Small County and Municipality Government Enterprise Agreement for geographic information system (GIS) software licensing with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., for an amount not-to-exceed \$191,628.

DISCUSSION

The Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District's (District) current three-year Enterprise Agreement with Environment Systems Research Institute, Inc., (Esri) expires January 2026. Renewing this agreement will allow the District to continue using Esri's comprehensive suite of geographic information system (GIS) software to deliver cartographic maps, manage GIS databases, conduct spatial analysis, and host web mapping applications. The General Manager recommends renewing the three-year Esri Enterprise Agreement for an amount not-to-exceed \$191,628.

PROCURMENT PROCESS AND SELECTION

Esri is the sole source designer and supplier for ArcGIS, the GIS software used by the District. There are no alternative licensing sources since Esri has proprietary ownership and no channel partners for selling its software. Esri offers a specially priced small municipal and county government packaged enterprise agreement that saves the District approximately \$208,000 annually on required software licenses and annual maintenance fees. Board Policy 3.03, *Public Contract Bidding, Vendor and Professional Consultant Selection and Purchasing Policy* provides that a sole source finding can be made "when supplies, materials, equipment, or services are of a unique type, are of a proprietary nature, or are otherwise of such a required and specific design or construction, or are for purposes of maintaining consistency and operational efficiency, so as to be available from only one source."

PRIOR BOARD ACTION SUPPORTING THE PROJECT

October 12, 2022: The Board authorized the General Manager to renew a three-year Small County and Municipality Government Enterprise Agreement for GIS software licensing with Esri for an amount not-to-exceed \$165,000. (R-22-114, meeting minutes). This agreement ends in January 2026.

NEXT STEPS
