



Adopt Resolution Appointing Director Pete Siemens as the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District's representative with the Santa Clara County Special District's Association (SCCSDA)

GENERAL MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION



SUMMARY

The District has a history of participation in the activities of the SCCSDA, through the local Santa Clara County Chapter. It has been some time since the Board has formally designated who will represent the District in these activities of the SCCSDA. The SCCSDA seeks a current acknowledgement of that designation from the Board, primarily for insurance purposes.

DISCUSSION

On July 11, 2012, the Board approved a Resolution (No. 12-34) supporting the inclusion of special districts on the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) in Santa Clara County. The representation of special districts on the LAFCo would be done through the SCCSDA. This is a most recent and powerful example of the various ways in which the SCCSDA is an important and valuable place for collaboration between special districts.

In order to effectively participate in the activities of the SCCSDA, it is necessary to designate a representative, and an alternate representative, to the SCCSDA.

WHEREAS, the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District has a history of participation in activities of the Santa Clara County Special Districts Association (SCCSDA); and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2012, the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District's Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 12-34 supporting the inclusion of special districts on the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) in Santa Clara County; and

WHEREAS, the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District Board of Directors has found such activities constitute activities in the course and scope of such individual's employment with or position of director with the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE DISTRICT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS that the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District appoints Director Pete Siemens as the District Representative and General Manager Steve Abbors as the Alternate Representative on the Santa Clara County Special District's Association.
