- item 11367 - \$26, 210 for Amah Mutsun conservation easement - what was this for?

Natural Resources staff worked with the Amah Mutsun Land Trust (AMLT) over the last year at Mt. Um. The Amah Mutsun Native Stewardship Corps engages young adult tribal members in the research, conservation, and education work to which AMLT is committed. It brings the Mutsun people back to their tribal homelands to resume the indigenous stewardship work of their ancestors. They provided the labor force to remove priority invasive species on Mount Umunhum as well as provided cultural education to Midpen staff. Midpen biologists worked with their crew to provide education on invasive species, treatment methods, impacts, as well as how to do botanical monitoring. This laid the groundwork for current and future work with the Amah Mutsun.
